PRICE FABER. PLACE - PRIZE OF POIRIERS (MAIDEN) - Penshurst finds its day



Penshurst (Fastnet Rock) won his third outing. The representative of OTI Management is one of the products of Fastnet Rock (Danehill) that this Australian team bought in Europe.

Tenacious Penshurst has made his mark on photography. Antoine de Watrigant's boarder remained on two second places for his first two attempts and ahead of Boy Royal (Myboycharlie) with a nose. The latter, still among the leading horses, had a sudden movement at the entrance of the straight line. His partner Maryline Eon could not stop him from leaning on his left. Mont Doré (Kendargent) is third, two and a half lengths.

The family of Penny's Picnic. Raised by Lynch Bages Limited, Penshurst is a son of Fastnet Rock (Danehill), a stallion at Coolmore and Penny's Gold (Kingmambo). She is the recipient of the Prix de la Calonne (L) and the Prix Quincey (Gr3) in France. She also developed in the United States by winning a Gr3. Penshurst is his first winner. The second mother, Penny's Valentine (Storm Cat) won once and placed third in Premio Regina Elena (Gr2). At the stud, she gave Zerky (Kingmambo), own sister of Penny's Gold and mother of Penny's Picnic (Kheleyf), a stallion at the Hoguenet stud farm, winner of the Critérium de Maisons-Laffitte (Gr2) and Prix Eclipse (Gr3).
